About the VCE



Glossary of Terms

VCE: Victorian Certificate of Education

- **Units 1 and 2:** subjects mainly studied at Year 11 in semesters one and two.
- **Units 3 and 4:** subjects mainly studies at Year 12 in semesters one and two, but may also be studied in Year 11.

VCAA: Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority

VCE VET: Vocational Education and Training. These are Courses such as Hebrew, Fashion or Hospitality; contribute to a student's VCE.



Glossary of Terms

ATAR: the ATAR is an acronym for the Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank

- used by Universities to select students for courses.
- The ATAR** is calculated by the VTAC (not the VCAA) on the scaled scores for:
 - English or English Lit or ESL and
 - the next 3 best scores and
 - 10% of the 5th score and
 - 10% of the 6th score (if applicable)

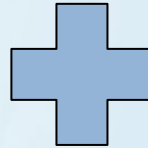

Year 10 Subject Selection

Core subjects:

- Hebrew - VET or support or Units 1/2
- Judaic Studies
- English
- Maths – Mainstream, Foundation or Units 1/2
- Science
- Humanities
- Physical Education and Sport



2 Elective subjects per semester

- **Exploratory Electives** and/or
- **General Electives**



Vocational Education and Training (optional)



Certificate of Applied Languages - Hebrew

- **After Certificate II – certificate**
- **After Certificate III – a 10% increment to the student's ATAR**
- **During timetabled classes**
- **No extra cost on top of school fees**
- **Counts as the Jewish Studies subject in any year studied**



Pathways for VET Hebrew

- 2018: complete Cert II Hebrew + all other core Year 10 subjects

then

- 2019: complete 4 Unit 1/2 studies + one Unit 3/4 study + Cert III Hebrew

then

- 2020: complete 4 Unit 3/4 studies one of which is a Jewish subject



Pathways for VET Hebrew

or

- 2018: complete Cert II Hebrew + all other core Year 10 subjects

then

- 2019: complete 5 Unit 1/2 studies (one of which is a Jewish subject) + one Unit 3/4 study

then

- 2020: complete Cert III Hebrew + four Unit 3/4 studies



VET Hebrew Requirements

- all assessments must be completed in Year 10 to achieve the Cert II
- Students must complete all Cert II assessments by November 2nd, 2018 or they won't be permitted to enrol in the Cert III in 2019 or 2020
- Students will not be permitted to attend the 9 week Ulpan program unless ALL Cert II assessments have been completed prior to departure.

Changes to the ATAR Increment Rule from 2019

Unscored increments which previously contributed 10% of the average of the primary four, including those for unscored VCE VET and VFE block credit, will instead be calculated using
10% of the lowest study score of the primary four.
